
## ASSOCIATE: INTERNATIONAL LUNAR OBSERVATORY

The International Lunar Observatory (ILO) is a low-cost, fast-turnaround, multi-wavelength space astronomy mission intended to land in the South Pole Region of the Moon by the 2008 Olympics. The ILO is envisioned as the first step toward human lunar base build-out leading to a permanent human presence on the Moon, and is intended to be as international an effort as possible. Exact landing location, wavelength spectrum, spacecraft configuration, and potential financiers, users and supporters will be determined through the ILO Advisory Committee Workshop on Hawai'i Island, November 17-20, 2005.
